

1920s Newspaper

Due: Friday, January 23rd

Points: 60

Content Standard: 11.5 Students analyze the major political, social, economic, technological, and cultural developments of the 1920s

Objective: Students will analyze the 1920s and develop an understanding of the important items of the 1920s and how the affected American society.

Task: Working in groups of 4, students will create a newspaper that focuses on the important people/events/things of the 1920s; explaining what they are and why they are important to American society.

Guidelines:

1. Each group member will contribute 1 page to the newspaper.
2. Each group member will write about a different part of American society:
 - a. Page 1 is *Headline News* and will focus on the most important parts of the 1920s
 - b. Pages 2-4 will be devoted to *Technology, Politics and Economics*, and *Sports and Entertainment*
3. Each group must decide who will do what page, and what to put on each page.
4. Each group must decide on a title of their newspaper, to put on the top at the front page.
5. Each page must include two short articles about two different parts of the page theme.
6. Where it says “by” create a different author for each article. Include a title of the article right above where it says “by”
7. There are two boxes on the left:
 - a. In one box put an illustration of your theme
 - b. In the other box, put an advertisement for something that would have been on sale in the 1920s.
