

1950s Collage

Due: Wednesday, March 11th

Points: 60

Content Standard: 11.8 Students analyze the economic boom and social transformation of post–World War II America.

Task: Students will make a collage of the 1950s to include the important people, events, and innovations in U.S. society, as well as some things that remained unchanged. Students will also type a 1 page summary of the 1950s, focusing on what changed and what stayed the same.

Materials: Construction/poster paper and colors (hand drawn preferred, but computer generated is acceptable).

Guidelines:

1. Include images (hand drawn preferable, computer generated are fine)
2. Cover as much of the poster/construction paper as possible
3. Include images from all parts of society: politics, economy, pop culture, civil rights, etc.
4. Include a 1 page, typed summary of the decade.
 - a. Typed, 12 pt. font
 - b. Times New Roman
 - c. Double spaced.
 - d. Type name in the upper right hand corner, push “enter” once.
 - e. Title, “1950s”, push enter once, begin typing.
5. The summary should be about what changed and what stayed the same in American society in the 1950s.
