

**Point Value:** 100 pts.

**Topics:** The individual you chose can be from any time in U.S. history up to the end of the Progressive Era, 1919. *An individual can only be used by one student.*

**Task:** Students will create an original piece of artwork dedicated to their individual in history AND a 3 page research paper about their individual.

**Art:**

- May be 3D projects, photography, computer generated images, or drawn in charcoal, pencil, watercolor, acrylics or oils.
- Must be neat and creative
- Must demonstrate effort
- Must include an artists' statement that gives the title of the piece, and explains how the art addresses the prompt. Statement should not exceed 500 words.

**Paper**

- 3 pages, typed, double-spaced
- Times New Roman
- Name, period in the upper right hand corner; push enter once; type the title; push enter 3 times; begin typing
- Include page numbers
- Include a bibliography/works cited page ([www.bibme.org](http://www.bibme.org))
- Must include at least 5 sources; 2 of which must be books.
- MLA or Chicago Manual of Style format
- *No Wikipedia as a source*

**Presentation**

- Must be ready to present your artwork in class.
- 5 minute presentation
