

Civil War Battles

Due: October, 13th

Points: 40

Objective: Students will gain an understanding of an important battle (and major turning point) of the Civil War by researching and analyzing a specific battle.

Battles:

1. Fall of Atlanta
2. Sherman's March to the Sea
3. Battle of Shiloh
4. First Battle of Bull Run,
5. Second Battle of Bull Run
6. Battle of Vicksburg (aka Vicksburg Campaign),
7. Cold Harbor,
8. Battle of Chattanooga
9. Battle of Fredericksburg

Task: Create card (much like the ones we used in class) of a battle listed below. Research a battle that you have not already read about.

1. Using the same size card as we used in class (provided), on one side provide the title and date of the battle.
2. On the same side as the title and date, include an image much like the ones we researched in class.
3. On the back, describe what happened during the battle, who won, and why it is considered an important battle of the Civil War.
4. Be prepared to share in class
