

## Early Cold War (1945-1965) Assessment

Due: Monday, 04/20

Points: 60

Content Standard: 11.9.3 Trace the origins and geopolitical consequences (foreign and domestic) of the Cold War and containment policy.

Objective: Students will gain an understanding of the early causes and events of the Cold War, and analyze their global significance.

Task Options: Make a brochure illustrating the early events of the Cold War, or complete a multiple choice exam.

Brochure:

1. Divide a sheet of paper into thirds
2. Include a cover page with an illustration.
3. On each page you will have an illustration of an event of the Cold War and at least 7 bullet points explaining the importance of each.
4. In total you will have a cover page and 3 pages about important events of the Cold War.

Illustrations:

1. Each page will have color
2. No stick figures
3. Use as much of the page as possible

Exam

1. Exam will be @35-40 questions covering the early Cold War. (Ch.13)

Rubric

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- Includes a cover page and at least 3 events of the Cold War.
- Contains illustrations on all pages.
- Color on all pages
- At least 7 bullet points for each event.
- Neat/organized
- Clear evidence of effort
- Creative
- Easy to read
- Contains relevant information AND includes the importance.

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- Does not have a cover page and/or at least 3 events.
- Some illustrations
- Color on some pages
- Less than 7 bullet points on some pages
- Tough to read
- Little effort
- Not very neat/organized

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- Missing some events.
- Illustrations on 2 or fewer pages
- Color on 2 or fewer pages
- No effort evident
- Few bullet points
- Irrelevant information; importance of the event is not evident.
