

Progressive Era Poster

Due Date: Wednesday, December 10th.

Points: 60

CA Content Standard: 11.2.9--Understand the effect of political programs and activities of the Progressives (e.g. federal regulation of railroad transport, Children's Bureau, the Sixteenth Amendment, Theodore Roosevelt, Hiram Johnson).

Objective ("Why are we doing this?"): Students will demonstrate an understanding of the Progressive Era and evaluate the successes and failures of the activities of the Progressives.

Task: Students will create a poster listing, explaining, and illustrating the successes and failures of the Progressive Movement.

Materials: Colors and poster paper will be provided.

Guidelines:

1. Students will list and briefly explain at least 8 problems in American society during the Progressive Movement.
2. Students will then list and explain at least 8 programs, laws, or activities of the Progressives to address those problems.
3. Must include illustrations.
4. Everybody in the group must participate and contribute to the creation of the poster.
5. Every group member will write a very short, paragraph summary of the most important success, most important failure, and why of the Progressive Era.

Use Chapter 5 (pages 326-357), your notes, and any other research to complete the project below. Answer each in complete sentences, and in complete paragraphs where indicated.
